GWO Basic Safety Training (BST) The aim of this module is to teach participants to use basic PPE, and how to safely execute work at heights and comprehensive basic rescue operations from heights in environments similar to those of wind turbines in compliance with the BST Working at Heights Module. In general, the course provides participants with basic knowledge and skills to enable them to work safely in the wind turbine industry.

Participants will learn Working at Heights, First Aid, Manual Handling and Fire Awareness tasks under the supervision of an experienced technician.

Upon completion of the GWO (BST) modules, candidates will meet the requirements for new employees and the handling of emergency situations in the wind turbine industry.
